

Greeting Track & Field Coaches,

Thank you for choosing to participate in our prestigious 2nd Annual Green & Gold Invitational Track & Field Meet. We are excited to be hosting an event that will one day be described as one of the biggest meets in Long Island. This year, we will be showcasing our freshman and sophomore athletes by giving the top 6 the opportunity to win medals in their respective events.

This track meet will be held on Saturday, May 10, 2025, at the Donald R. Ross Track & Field Complex at Westbury High School. The address is 1 Post Road, Old Westbury, New York 11568. All events are scheduled to begin at 10:00am SHARP. Therefore, the track will be open starting at 9:00am for all warm-ups, run-throughs, marks, and measurements. Buses should arrive no later than 9:30am because there will be a coaches meeting at 9:45am. The track will close at 9:55am. Athletes who still need to warm-up after the track is closed can use the outer perimeter of the stadium behind the gate and the bleachers. After the opening ceremony, the track will be reopened for all warm-ups, run-throughs, marks, and measurements at 12:45pm briefly. It will close at 12:55pm so the remainder of the meet can begin at 1:00pm SHARP.

This year we will be serving breakfast in the morning and bringing back our "Taste of The Caribbean" lunch and dinner options that will have you running back for more! In addition, our commemorative Green & Gold T-shirts will be available for purchase. Meet & Seeding Reminders



- All athletes can only compete in 3-events
- Top 6 athletes will advance to the finals in the hurdles, and 100m. All other events will be considered a final based on the top times ran
- Top 7 will advance to finals in all jumps and throws in Varsity ONLY
- The FIRST LEGAL jump/ throw will be marked. All other jumps/ throws must meet the minimum standard to be marked
- Starting blocks can only be used in the first 2 seeded heats of the 200m, 400m, 4 x 100m Relay, 4 x 400m Relay, and finals
- Our finish line will feature Fully Automatic Timing. Finish Right Timing will have live results at www.finishright.com
- Only ¹/₈ pyramid spikes are acceptable in either 5 spike or 6 spike shoe models. All spikes must be check by an official prior to competing
- Teams must supply their own batons
- All athletes participating in both running and field events must notify the field event officials prior to leaving and then again when they return

Scoring and Awards Criteria



- A 1st place trophy will be presented to the winners of each INVITATIONAL event
- Medals will be awarded to athletes who placed 2nd through 6th in INVITATIONAL events
- Medals will be given to the top 6 place holders in the freshman/ sophomore, varsity, and open events
- Teams can earn points for the top 6 places holding athletes in each event,

- 1st Place: 10 points

- 4th Place: 4 points

- 2nd Place: 8 points

- 5th Place: 2 points

- 3rd Place: 6 points

- 6th Place: 1 point

- A 1st place trophy will be presented to the Boys and Girls teams that accumulated the most points
- The *Outstanding Athlete Award* will be presented to one male and female athlete of the meet.

- Once athletes have been dropped off, all buses should park in the Westbury Middle School Parking lot located at 455 Rockland Street, Westbury, New York 11590
- Athletes **MUST** display sportsmanship throughout the meet. Taunting, fighting, destroying property, or other behaviors that are deemed unsportsmanlike will not be tolerated at all.


Registration Guidelines


